#### **Support Boat Agency Contact Details**

For overseas crews and any local teams that need a support boat, please contact Carmen from Standard Boat Agency well in advance.

Support Boats are "Mandatory for the Iron and Relay Races" – **not** the 10k race. Every crew is required to have a support boat alongside them throughout the race. There must be a designated **Support Manager** on board who will keep in regular contact with race safety officials.

Spectator Boats are Optional: Junk Boats may **not** be used as support boats for the race. Junks may be used for spectators, but they must remain behind the boat they are supporting and must not impede other crews or any support boats.

# Celebration Party and Medal Presentation - Sunday 1 December


All medals will be presented at the post-race celebration party on Sunday 1 December. The Post Race event is scheduled as follows:


